I. Guideline for Program (For Overseas Applicants)

1. Qualification for Applicant

- (a) The applicant should have been active as a non-profit-making organization for more than 3 consecutive years.
- (b) The organization should be authorized by the local or central government, or an equivalent body.
- (c) Total annual project cost (actual project expenditure) should be less than USD 100,000.
- (d) An organization that can submit application through an associate organization or a supporting group in Japan is preferred.

2. Eligible Projects

The project should;

- (a) be educational and targeted for children in developing countries.
- (b) have continuous aspects, and the follow-up activities are required after the projects completion.
- (c) be conducted by the applicant firsthand both in planning and implementation.
- (d) be started and completed between April 1, 2009 and March 31, 2010.
- (e) show appropriate and reasonable purpose, budget and expected outcomes...

The maximum amount of a grant is Yen1, 500,000 in Japanese currency.

Interim reports as of the end of June, September and December are required

. and tThe final report should be submitted immediately after the completion of the project.

3. Language

Applicants could use either English or Japanese in communication.

II.Application and Selection

1. Application Process

- (1) Our special application form should be requested via postal mail only.
- (2) Application should satisfy the below.
 - ① Application period: should arrive at our office between September 1 and October 31, 2008.
 - ② Language: English or Japanese
 - ③ Method : postal mail only (Other method are not accepted)
 - ④ We will process only the applications which meet criteria as stated above

2. Selection Process

After review process by our Selection Committee, the Board of Directors will make a final decision (the meeting will be held in February 2009).

3. Grant

To be remitted to the approved applicant in March 2009.
